He's known in Houston as "Mattress Mack," the highly visible owner of Gallery Furniture who stands ready to help people come wind, flood or pandemic.

Most recently, he's been busy helping to provide breakfast and lunch for Houston children out of school due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and getting care packages to senior citizens who are shut in by the need for social distancing.

In horse racing, he's known as the man behind Runhappy, responsible for all the TV commercials, race sponsorships and track banners touting the Eclipse Champion Sprinter whose first foals are 2-year-olds this year.

But in Louisiana, James "Mack" McIngvale is known as one of the top breeders in the state. He has recently been named 2019

Louisiana Leading Breeder by percentage of stakes winners for the second consecutive year.

"First of all, it's adjacent to Texas. I'm a Louisiana fan. They make it advantageous for a breeder such as myself to support the Louisiana program." McIngvale

says.

"I think they pay more money. The purses are big. They run all year long. There are lots of Louisiana-bred only races. I think there are a ton of advantages. Plus it's a tax-friendly state.

"People in Louisiana love horse racing and support it tremendously."

McIngvale has a special fondness for Fair Grounds, where his aunt kindled his interest in horse racing when he was a child. He won the Louisiana Derby with Wimbledon in 2004.

"My aunt used to love to go to the Fair Grounds," he says. "I'm from Mississippi, so my aunt took me to the Fair Grounds many times. That attracted me to the game and here I am. I love the game, and it all started at the Fair Grounds."

Currently, McIngvale's most well-known Louisiana bred is

Underpressure, a 6-year-old gelding by Belmont Stakes winner Birdstone out of McIngvale's mare Charming Colleen, by Charismatic. Underpressure is owned by Mallory Greiner.

At this writing, Underpressure has 13 wins from 37 starts with seven seconds and seven thirds, for earnings of \$744,582. He regularly contests the state-bred championship races at Fair Grounds, Delta Downs and Evangeline Downs. Wins include Delta's Premier Night Championship Stakes (2020), the Champions Day Classic at Fair Grounds (2018), the Louisiana Legends Cheval Stakes at Evangeline Downs (2017) and the Premier Night Prince at Delta (2017).

Underpressure has also run out of state at Oaklawn, Prairie Meadows, Canterbury Park, Parks Racing, Indiana Grand Race Course and Churchill Downs. He is trained by Chris Richard, who is also the principal trainer for McIngvale in Louisiana. Underpressure was named champion Louisiana bred as a 3-year-old.

California-bred Charming Colleen was stakes placed in her day, running third in the 2005 Grade 1 Las Virgenes Stakes and fourth in that year's Grade 1 Santa Anita Oaks. She is also the dam of Freedomfi, a 3-year-old colt by Guilt Trip who ran second behind state-bred sensation No Parole in this year's Premier Night Prince at Delta. Guy Smith trains Freedomfi.

Freedomfi's full sister, Goodprofit, was recently retired and is scheduled to be bred to Runhappy. The 4-year-old filly

won the Louisiana Jewel Stakes at Delta as a 2-year-old and the Premier Night Starlet at Delta as a 3-year old last year.

Laura Wohlers, McIngvale's sister-in-law, is the main trainer and oversees a 20-stall barn at the Thoroughbred Training Center in Lexington, Ky. There are five 3-year olds running and 11 2-year-olds in the barn. The Novel Coronavirus pandemic has left her racing plans for the 2-year-olds up in the air, but she usually sends three or four broodmares to Louisiana to foal out every year.

The young horses are broken and started in Lexington. The Louisiana bred may run once or twice at Churchill Downs or Indiana Grand before being sent south to take advantage of the state-bred races.

Texas might seem to be a logical place for McIngvale to breed and race, but Wohlers is not enthusiastic about the Texas state-bred program. "We put a few other mares in some other states' program, but the Louisiana program is what really got us started," she says. "Here in the wintertime when only Turfway is open we really concentrate on our babies, so it's nice to be able to have some run in Louisiana."

It was Richard, who worked for her after college and later for Tom Amoss, who talked her into sending horses to him in Louisiana.

"I felt like Louisiana was close, in case Mack wanted to go over and see the horses," she says. "We've been real happy with the program. We have [the broodmares] at Jay Adcock's farm. A friend of mine recommended Jay, and he takes great care of them."

With 11 broodmares and Runhappy to prove as a stallion, there are plenty of yearlings and 2-year-olds coming along. Wohlers says McIngvale prefers to breed to race rather than sell.

McIngvale says Runhappy was just too good to let go after his racing career, so he retains many shares of the syndicate formed to stand him at Claiborne Farm. The heavy, multi-faceted promotion of the stallion springs from McIngvale's career in the furniture (and mattress) business.

"I love advertising and selling furniture. I'm a natural-born marketer, so when this wonderful, life-changing horse named Runhappy came along, it was up to me. He made his name on the track. Now I'm trying to make his name in the stallion business. His foals are going to have to hit the ground running this year and make him a great stallion, but my job was advertising to make people aware of him."

As some of those Runhappy babies are Louisiana bred, look for the stallion to make an impact here soon.

SECRET CIRCLE

It's not every day that a Breeders' Cup winner joins the Louisiana stallion roster, but in January 2020, Chad Schumer of Schumer Bloodstock brokered a deal to bring Secret Circle to Elite Thoroughbreds from Hill 'n' Dale Farms. The stallion is believed to be the first Breeders' Cup Sprint (G1) winner to stand in the state and is available at a fee of \$3,000 live foal payable September 1, or \$3,500 stands and nurses.

While Secret Circle only made 16 starts across five seasons of racing, he packed some punch when he did appear on the track. He was an undefeated juvenile in three starts, his victories including the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Sprint (a listed race) and the Jack Goodman Stakes at Santa Anita. At 3, he stretched out to take the Rebel Stakes (G2) over a mile and one-sixteenth and the Southwest Stakes (G3) at a mile; he was also second to Bodemeister in the nine-furlong Arkansas Derby (G1) and second in the one-mile Sham Stakes (G3).

Secret Circle came out of the Arkansas Derby with a sesamoid injury and was away from the races until October 14 of the following year, when he won a six-furlong allowance optional claimer at Santa Anita in a sharp 1:07:98. Primed by his race over the track, he then turned in the race of his life in the Xpress.bet Breeders' Cup Sprint (G1), coming from off the pace to score by a neck over Laugh Track.

Secret Circle didn't quite manage a Breeders' Cup Sprint repeat in 2014 (he was second); in fact, he failed to win that year from five starts. He placed in four stakes races, however, including the Sprint and a second behind Private Zone in the Cigar Mile (G1). At 6, he added one more major win with a gritty triumph in the Dubai Golden Shaheen (G1). He retired having been first or second in 14 of his 16 races and with earnings of \$3,670,790.

Such consistency and class made Secret Circle the top runner sired by Pimlico Special Handicap (G1) winner Eddington, in turn a son of 1990 champion 3-year-old male and important sire Unbridled. This is a male line more noted for stamina than raw speed, and

Eddington himself had that tendency reinforced in his breeding as he was out of a mare who was a daughter of Chief's Crown and a maternal granddaughter of Sir Ivor. Nonetheless, as pointed out by pedigree expert Alan Porter, the cross of Unbridled and his sons over Dixieland Band mares has tended to produce more speed and less stamina than the bloodlines might suggest.

Dixieland Band's daughter Ragtime Hope, the dam of Secret Circle, produced four foals by Eddington, and the three that started were all winners over sprint distances. She herself won the 5-furlong Catcharisingstar Stakes at 2 and the 8.5-furlong Noble Robyn Stakes at 3, both at Florida's Calder Race Course (now Gulfstream Park West). A half sister to 1998 Dogwood Stakes (G3) winner and grade 1-placed Really Polish (by Polish Numbers), Ragtime Hope is out of Good 'n' Smart (by Smarten), a winning full sister to grade 3 winner Chesire Kitten. The next dam in the female line is the Forli mare Smiling Cece, a juve-

nile winner and a half sister to the stakes-winning juvenile Desert Boy (by Desert Wine).

Secret Circle's stud record to date is acceptable at face value but is probably better than it looks. This is because of his positioning in the Kentucky market, where he entered stud in 2016 at a fee of \$5,000. That fee would be respectable for a first-year sire in a regional market, indicating a horse likely to be backed by mare support from its owner(s). In Kentucky, a \$5,000 fee is bargain basement and signals a horse attended by low expectations, which tends to become a self-fulfilling prophecy.

Under the circumstances, Secret Circle did not do badly as a first-crop sire of 2019. From a pool of mates of mediocre quality, he sired 45 named foals, of which 23 started and 10 won as juveniles. Two were stakes-placed, and Secret Circle has since added two more starters, four more winners, and two more stakes-placed runners (including one in a non-blacktype stakes) from his first crop, now 3-year-olds.

Secret Circle is an outcross to the A.P. Indy male line, and both Northern Dancer and Mr. Prospector are far enough back in his pedigree that most of the available mare base should be open to him, though breeders wishing to experiment with inbreeding to Unbridled using mares sired by sons or grandsons of Unbridled's Song will want to be careful to ensure that the mares used are free from the foreleg faults commonly associated with Unbridled. It may be worth noting that Secret Circle has two winners from mares from the relatively uncommon male line of Relaunch, one from a mare whose dam is by a Relaunch-line sire, and one whose broodmare sire is out of a full sister to Relaunch, suggesting a possible affinity.



Physically, Secret Circle is a typical sprinter with short coupling and plenty of muscle. "He's very strongly made," says Michele Rodriguez of Elite Thoroughbreds. "He's not a little blocky horse, though; he's about 16.1 hands. He's correct and can get a nice-looking baby. Plus, he's got a great mind. He's very intelligent with a good disposition and is easy to handle. He's in Louisiana right now because his owners didn't want him to go overseas. They believe in him, that he can be a good stallion in the right market, and they're willing to lose what they could get by selling him to back that up."

As of March 18, Secret Circle already has 15 runners and five winners in 2020 and is the Southwest region's leading second-crop sire by a wide margin, so the early indications are favorable that his owners may win their gamble. In the meantime, if he keeps turning out the winners, Kentucky's loss will be Louisiana's gain.

Never has an accredited Louisiana Bred come so close to winning a Breeders' Cup race than when Chimney Rock got beat by three quarters of a length in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf.

Having broke his maiden in a Maiden Special Weights race at Saratoga on September 1st he was vanned down to Kentucky Downs to run in the Kentucky Downs Juvenile Turf Sprint just six day later and failed by a head in the \$500,000 race. A month later found him failing by a half length in the Indian Summer Stakes at Keeneland.

His Breeders' Cup race was followed by him finally ending up in the winners' circle following his triumph in the Louisiana Champions Day Juvenile, his first venture on a dirt surface.

The son of turf specialist Artie Schiller is the first stakes winner produced by the Wheaton dam, What's Your Point, although she previously produced the stakes placed Dubai Chanel to the cover of E Dubai. Bred by Stargazers LLC and Clear Creek Stud LLC Chimney Rock has a half sister Two-Year-Old by Half Ours named Lady Churchill that is still owned by the breeders.

In addition to being voted Champion Two-Year-Old Colt or Gelding, Chimney Rock was also selected as the overall Horse of the Year. No other accredited Louisiana Bred has earned more than the \$369,025 Chimney Rock earned in 2019.

She is the first stakes winner produced by the Eddington dam, Edacious Reality, who produced a full brother to Net A Bear in 2018, a Mo Tom filly in 2019 and recently produced a filly by the Speightstown stallion

Being the only Accredited Louisiana bred Three-Year-Old Colt of Gelding to win three stakes races for the year made Shang an easy choice for his championship year.

A neck win in the Louisiana Premier Night Prince Stakes at Delta Downs in February started the year off right. He quickly followed that win by capturing the Crescent City Derby at Fair Grounds in March, a race he led for most of the race then drew off in the stretch to a final margin of eight plus lengths. In May he added the Louisiana Legends Cheval Stakes to his resume. In July he ran in the Iowa Derby and should have won, fouled badly in the stretch by the winner he was moved up from third to second in the \$250,000 race.

For the year the son of Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner, Shanghai Bobby earned \$232,500.

The 17th annual Louisiana Premier Night at Delta Downs on Feb. 8 featured plenty of hoof-pounding action highlighting the state's best four-legged athletes. Upsets, cliff-hangers, domination and a possible Triple Crown entry were on tap for the 11-race card, which included 10 stakes races totaling \$900,000 of purse money. The night ended with Delta Downs handling \$2,272,676 in betting.

Underpressure's first stakes win came during the 2017 edition of Louisiana Premier Night when, as a 3-year-old, won the \$100,000 Prince as a 9-1 longshot. A year later, the son of Birdstone returned to LAPN for the \$150,000

Championship, but was defeated by a neck to Mobile Bay. Last year – a sixth place finish.

The Chris Richard trainee had 2020 vision as the 6-year-old gelding rallied from 5 lengths back to win the illustrious \$150,000 with veteran Gerard Melancon in the irons.

“Underpressure is very competitive and he always shows up,” said Richard. “He came into this race as good as he has ever trained. Gerard did a great job keeping him closer to the pace that he normally does.”

The overwhelming 1-2 favorite Shang led for most of the one mile and one sixteenth race with moderate fractions of 24.17, 48.81 and 1:13.689. As the six-horse field turned for home, Shang gave up the lead to Jose Camejo’s Pound for Pound took over. That’s when Underpressure (\$12.40) made his move.

Melancon moved up the rail, then angled out down the stretch to pass Pound for Pound near the wire to win by a half-length in 1:45.41 over a fast track.

“It’s a pleasure to ride this horse,” said Melancon. “You can put him anywhere you want him.” It was also Melancon’s first win since his late father George Melancon Sr. was buried earlier in the week.

Winning owner Mallory Greiner was also emotional after the win. “We nearly lost Underpressure with complications after gelding him,” she said. “He is a class act, a puppy dog.”

The final order of finish was Underpressure, Pound for Pound, Star Fitzstall, Mageez, Shang and Trevilion.

Underpressure has since returned to the track and won the \$70,000 Owner Appreciation Stakes on Feb. 29 at Delta Downs. The Louisiana bred is 13-36 lifetime with earnings of \$741,382.

“She is an amazing mare who loves Delta Downs,” said trainer Victor Arceneaux. “This is her seventh win in 13 starts here in Vinton.”

Arceneaux added that Mariah’s Galaxy began to blossom as a 5-year-old winning three of five starts including two stakes at Delta such as the Magnolia Stakes and Treasure Chest.

Ashley Broussard and 12-1 shot Tenpins Tempo shot out of the gate first and led for most of the race thanks to modest fractions of 23.75 and 49.22.

Kevin Smith shook the reins as the daughter of

Greeley's Galaxy took off down the stretch and coasted to a four-length win in 1:39.48.

"She's awesome," said Smith. "You just sit back and let her do her thing. Anytime you ask something of her, she does it."

Mariah's Galaxy (\$3.60) improved to 10-26 with a bankroll total of \$384,985.

The son of Violence was stretched out for the first time after winning two 6-furlong starts at the Fair Grounds and had no issues winning the \$100,000 LAPN Prince by 6 1/2 lengths.

"He was very relaxed going around two turns for the first time," said winning rider James Graham. "He is very explosive and has done everything too easy."

Graham and the 1-5 favorite took the first quarter in 23.92 then slowed down to nearly a crawl at 49.39 for

the half split. Once the two reach the stretch, neither had to do much as the colt took off to finish the mile in 1:39.93.

BUILDING ON FAMILY TRADITIONS

Nestled in the rural community of Loranger in Tangipahoa County is a 640-acre Thoroughbred farm noted for exemplary care and horsemanship. Averett Farm has spanned over forty years as a family-owned endeavor in a time when such operations are becoming a rarity. Gerald, nicknamed “Dewey” Averett, and his mother Margie Averett have built a successful family tradition of raising and racing their own thoroughbreds with continued success on the Louisiana racing circuit. With a longstanding philosophy built on good bloodlines, sound horsemanship skills and well-bred horses, the Averett

way is keeping it all in the family.

“My father Gerald, Sr. was a Quarter Horse trainer back in the 1970s and 80s,” Gerald recalled. “We raced mostly in Louisiana and Texas, but the meets for Quarter Horses were always short and there wasn’t much local opportunity. We had to travel a long distance to the races, and it seemed like we were always on the road. Mom (Margie) kept the books, dad trained, and I broke horses, barrel raced and galloped. We kept it all in the family, worked hard, and had a lot of fun in those days.”

“One of our favorite [quarter] horses that we eventually stood at

stud was Rovargas,” Gerald said. “He was a hard knocking racehorse who eventually became a well-known sire of some very good runners.”

Rovargas, whose unusual name was a combination of the last names of his breeders E.C. Roge and Richard De Vargas, was a foal of 1973 sired by the Jet Deck stallion Roge’s Won Bar out of the Three Bars line mare Roge’s Mosquito. A durable racehorse, Rovargas compiled 10 wins from 65 starts. His most notable offspring is the Grade 2 stakes winner Magic Mighty Man whose dam was Louisiana Quarter Horse

Breeder's Association Hall of Fame inductee Oh Black Magic.

The Quarter Horse racing and breeding industry experienced a drastic economic swing during the 1980s with a decline in breeding, purse monies and quality racing. As a result, the Averett's chose to make the switch to raising and racing their own Thoroughbreds in an economic landscape that was only slightly more favorable at the time.

"Quarter Horse racing had lost it's luster," Gerald said. "The purse money was dropping, and you had to travel farther and farther away to race. You couldn't make any money selling your good stock. We sold most of our Quarter Horses as barrel racing prospects. There just wasn't any money in it so we decided to start raising and racing our own Thoroughbreds."

The Louisiana Thoroughbred Breeders' Association breeder's incentive program made it a profitable endeavor for Louisiana

horsemen to raise and race their own stock. The increased purses and inauguration of the Louisiana Champions Day in 1991, a series of Louisiana-bred races at Fair Grounds, gave rise to higher prices for Louisiana bred and an increased purse structure that has provided a wealth of incentives for

breeders to produce higher quality Thoroughbreds.

"It was just a natural move for us," Gerald stated. "We raise about sixty foals per year, and race our own. We offer our foals for sale as soon as they are weaned. We don't sell our horses at public auction. The way we do it is a little different than others. Our weanlings are offered for sale at the farm for \$3,000, yearlings at \$4,000 and two-year-olds for \$5,000.

"The youngsters that aren't sold by the time they are ready to be broken go into our racing program. We don't specifically choose who will stay and who will go. From the time the babies are weaned anyone can have their choice. My cousin Ronnie (Averett) trains our horses, and so the whole family gets to enjoy the upside of the program."

Foaling out sixty mares takes experience, timing, knowledge and tender care. Gerald's fiance' Michelle Hamilton oversees all of

the foaling and is present when the babies are born.

She and Gerald had a meeting of the minds when discussing the size of the foaling stalls.

“I met Michelle when she joined our staff working with the broodmares,” Gerald recollected with humor. “She eventually let me know that she thought the standard 12 x 14 foaling stalls were too small. I knew it was going to be quite a big construction project but eventually I caved in. Now all our foaling stalls are 20 x 20, and it gives the mares and foals so much more room to move around.”

When knowledge, passion and hard work come together success inevitably follows. Margie was named the 2017 LTBA Breeder of the Year. Margie’s homebred runners have earned \$1,755,902 overall between 2003-2020 with Wild Bert leading the way with earnings of \$196,530 and a fourth-place finish in the Louisiana Bred Premier Night Sprint Stakes on February 8. Another Averett-bred runner, Diamond Cutter, won the 2019 \$50,000 Louisiana Filly and Mare Sprint on Louisiana Cup Day over

a field of seven distaffers.

“Mom has always loved the horses and she continues to do so in spite of the fact that she has declined due to Alzheimer’s disease,” said Gerald. “I am now her caretaker, and it is important that she still has a link to everything happening on the farm. She doesn’t get out much anymore, but still enjoys hearing about all the new foals and racing. There is never a dull moment around here.”

In addition to the advent of new foals every spring, the Averett’s stand ten stallions including Sabercat, winner of the 2011 Delta Downs Jackpot Stakes (G2) and the earner of \$898,662. Sabercat, sired by Bluegrass Cat out of the Forty Niner mare Miner’s Blessing, won the 2011 Garden State Stakes at Monmouth Park. He was third behind Bodemeister and Secret Circle in the \$1-million 2012 Arkansas Derby (G1), ran in the 2012 Kentucky Derby (G1) and wrapped up his career with a third-place effort in the 2013 Oaklawn Handicap (G3). The impressive stallion roster standing at Averett’s farm includes Grade 1 winning mil-

lionaire Hard Aces, Grade 3 stakes winner Ocean Knight, and Grade 1 winner D’Wildcat.

The equine related activities going on at the Averett’s farm are not just centralized to thoroughbreds these days. When the weather warms up and the local kids are out of school the old barrel racing arena, still standing after all these years, is a whirlwind of activity. During the summer months, Averett Farm is host to horseback riding day-campers and a local instructor who teaches valuable horsemanship skills.

“The kids from the community come out here to ride during the summer,” said Gerald. “We have a local riding instructor who teaches barrel racing and western lessons. They (the kids) all come out with their own horses and have a great time. It is easy to get the horse bug when you are a child. You never know which one is going to be that future thoroughbred farm owner, the jockey, the trainer, the groom.

It is an experience that fosters a love of the horse and great life skills—no matter where the road takes you.”

Court Vision is now the first Louisiana based sire to have an Eclipse Award winning Champion to his credit.

Storm The Court (Court Vision-My Tejana Storm, by Tejano Run) was named the Champion 2-year-old Male, at last night's Eclipse Awards ceremonies. A near disastrous mishap in the Runhappy Del Mar Futurity in which favorite Eight Rings bumped Storm The Court causing both horses to lose their riders, could have ended his 2-year old season. However, the Kentucky bred colt came back to finish 3rd in the G1 American Pharoah Stakes before a longshot 45-1 victory in the G1 TVG Breeders' Cup Juvenile.

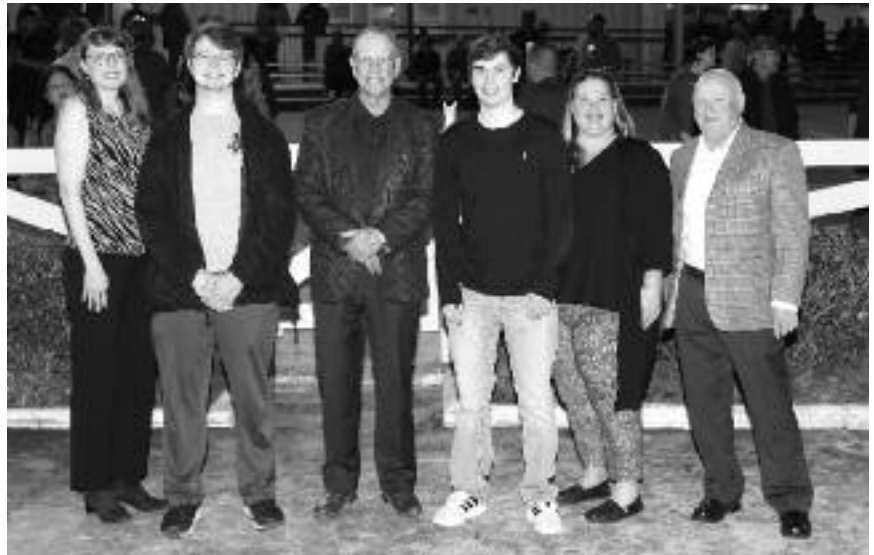

A.P. Indy Dies at 31

A.P. Indy, the 1992 Horse of the Year and one of the world's great stallions, died peacefully Feb. 21 at his longtime home at Lane's End near Versailles, Ky.

A.P. Indy, a son of Triple Crown winner Seattle Slew, was the leading sire twice, leading broodmare sire once, and among the leaders on both lists multiple times.

A son of Seattle Slew, A.P. Indy was bred in Kentucky by William

S. Farish III and William Kilroy, out of the Secretariat mare Weekend Surprise. He was the most expensive yearling of the 1990 auction calendar, consigned by Lane's End to the Keeneland July Select Yearling Sale and going to bloodstock agent Noel O'Callaghan of BBA Ireland for \$2.9 million.

Eclipse Awards for Horse of the Year and champion 3-year-old male came to A.P. Indy at the end of his sophomore campaign after compiling a resume that included wins in the G1 Belmont Stakes and Santa Anita Derby, the G2 San Rafael Stakes and Peter Pan Stakes, and a season and career finale score in the Breeders' Cup Classic at Gulfstream Park.

For as much as A.P. Indy achieved that season, he was poised to do even more. He was the morning line favorite for the 1992 Kentucky Derby, but a bone bruise discovered during a morning jog led to his being scratched the morning of the race.

The withdrawal ultimately cost A.P. Indy nothing when it came to year-end honors, and he finished his career at the end of his 3-year-old campaign with eight wins in 11 starts for earnings of \$2,979,815. A.P. Indy was voted into the National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame in 2000, the same year his trainer was inducted.

A.P. Indy had even more success as a stallion at Lane's End, where in 1993 he stood for \$50,000. By

His champions include classic winner Bernardini, Horse of the Year Mineshaft, Honor Code, and filly Rags to Riches, who beat the boys in the 2007 Belmont, edging eventual two-time Horse of the Year Curlin. He closed his stallion career in 2011.

A.P. Indy has 29 sons standing at stud, including Astrology who stands at Acadiana Equine at Copper Crowne in Opelousas.

The Equine Sales Company has set the date for their 2020 Consignor Select Yearling Sale. The sale will be held Thursday, September 3, 2020 at the Equine Sales Facility in Opleousas, Louisiana. The Thursday date was set as to not conflict with racing at Louisiana Downs.

Additionally, the Equine Sales Company has announced that, due to the uncertainty of juvenile sales dates this spring, it will be offering a limited number of stalls to owners and consignors of 2-year-olds in training to be entered. There will not be an under-tack show before the sale.

Any 2-year-old in training contracted to sell must have the following:

- Video of horse training/galloping under tack;
- A full series of repository X-rays submitted to Equine Sales Company repository within 30 days of going through sales ring; and,

In addition, if (not required) consignor has an official published work at a recognized training cen-

ter and/or race track within 30 days of sale, it is to be submitted to Equine Sales Company for verification.

The 2-year-olds will be cataloged and sold after the Consignor Select Yearling portion of the sale.

Deadline to submit the Equine Consignor Select Yearling Sale contract and fee(s) is June 12.

Texas Summer Yearling Sale Set for August 24 at Lone Star Park

This year's Texas Summer Yearling and Mixed Sale has been set for Monday, August 24, at Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie. This will mark the fifth renewal of the auction held jointly by the Texas Thoroughbred Association and Lone Star Park. The entry deadline is June 15.

Texas 2-Year-Old Sale Cancelled, Consignments to be Promoted Online

On March 23rd, the Texas Thoroughbred Association and Lone Star Park announced that the Texas 2-Year-Olds in Training Sale scheduled for April 3 has been cancelled due to the coronavirus pandemic. All entry fees for the sale will be refunded.

It was also announced that all horses currently nominated to the Texas Thoroughbred Futurity at Lone Star Park will remain eligible provided the final payment of \$350 is made. All horses entered in the 2-year-old sale will be considered to have passed through the sales ring for the purposes of eligibility for the race. Additionally, the April 15 due date for the final payment has been pushed back to May 15. The Texas Thoroughbred Futurity, with a fillies and colts/geldings division

for a \$100,000-estimated purse apiece, is scheduled for July 12 at Lone Star. The TTA and Lone Star will make a future announcement should a date change be needed.

"We are obviously disappointed to cancel this sale, especially with a record number of consignments, but it's really the only option at this point and postponing the sale simply was not feasible," said Mary Ruyle, executive director of the Texas Thoroughbred Association. "We are leaving the sale catalogue online and making some enhancements so that potential buyers can view photos and videos submitted by consignors and make contact to negotiate private sales."

"We feel this was probably the best group of horses to be catalogued to this sale in over a decade, so we encourage potential buyers to view the horses being offered," said Tim Boyce, sales director. "We truly appreciate all the support from consignors, so we are working to make the best of this situation and help buyers and sellers get connected."

The Texas Summer Yearling Sale is set for August 24 at Lone Star and will also include a horses of racing age session.

A trainer for more than 40 years, the Bossier City native was best known for his work with multiple graded stakes winner Brownsboro. Career win number 462 came when Smart Pegasus won the finale on Monday, February 24 at Fair Grounds.

Survivors include his parents, Allen “Al” and Leatrice “Lee” Viator of Lake Charles; two sisters, Debbie Viator Theriot (Tommy) of Sweetlake and D’Lissa Viator Cunningham (David) of Southlake, TX; two nieces and two nephews, Dr. Corey Theriot, Cheree Theriot, Catherine Cunningham, and Jac Cunningham.

(NSAIDs) and a ban on bronchodilators at all 2-year-old sales, and limited use of riding crops at under tack shows. The revised Conditions of Sale for each sales company are effective beginning in March 2020.

These proactive measures demonstrate continued uniformity among the United States’ three largest Thoroughbred auction houses and are the latest round of leadership reforms undertaken in recent years, following action in 2009 to ban the use of anabolic steroids in sales horses and last year’s ban on the off-label use of bisphosphonates in horses younger than four years old.

Medication Reforms

The following changes in the medication rules will be in place for all 2-year-old sales at each of the three auction companies:

- No more than one NSAID may be administered. Stacking of NSAIDS is prohibited; and
- Bronchodilators (Clenbuterol, Albuterol and all other bronchodilators) are prohibited substances and may not be administered.

No medication may be administered 24 hours prior to a horse's performance in an under tack show. The schedule for administration of permitted medication at Keeneland's April 2-Year-Olds in Training Sale will be governed by the rules of racing as set forth by the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission.

Use of a Riding Crop and Spurs at an Under Tack Show

All three sales companies now prohibit the excessive use of a riding crop on the track. Under the enhanced guidelines, a rider may remove his or her hands from the

reins and strike a horse once behind the girth only prior to the starting pole at which the horse begins to breeze. At any time after the start of the breeze, a rider may only use the riding crop while both hands are holding the reins and may not strike the horse behind the girth. A rider is prohibited from striking the horse in any manner beyond the finish line. In situations where the safety of the horse or rider is in jeopardy, a riding crop may be used in front of the girth. Spurs are not allowed.

Any infraction of this policy may result in a substantial fine to be paid by the consignor, and chronic offenders may be banned from riding on the sales grounds.

Sokol Named Louisiana Downs Racing Operations Manager

David Heitzmann, director of racing at Harrah's Louisiana Downs, announced that Jennifer Sokol has accepted the position of racing operations manager at the Shreveport racetrack. Sokol has been employed at Louisiana Downs since 2007, joining the racing office in 2012. She most recently served as racing office manager.

Her new duties will include supervision of the racing staff as well as overseeing handicapping seminars, racing promotions and other duties associated with the live Quarter Horse and Thoroughbred race meets.

Partial Interest Sold in Louisiana 3-Year-Old No Parole

Majority owner Maggi Moss said Feb. 13 that she has sold a

minority interest in Louisiana-bred 3-year-old No Parole has to Greg Tramontin.

No Parole won his first two races at Fair Grounds Race Course & Slots in six-furlong sprints before stretching out to two turns in the Feb. 8 Louisiana Bred Premier Night Prince Stakes at a mile at Delta Downs. Spurring to the lead, he relaxed and cruised under the wire 6 1/2 lengths in front under regular rider James Graham.

Moss is excited to race No Parole with Tramontin, the CEO of GoAuto Insurance. Moss said Tramontin is eager to get more involved in horse ownership after stepping away from the sport for a lengthy period. In recent years, Tramontin has owned a limited number of runners, some with New Orleans businessman Bobby Asaro.

"I had a lot of really nice offers on him," Moss said. "But they wanted all of him or they were going to move away from Tom. That was just a problem for me. One wanted to go to California, another one someplace else."

A \$75,000 yearling purchase by Moss at the 2018 Keeneland September Yearling Sale from Select Sales, agent for breeder Coteau Grove Farms, No Parole is by Violence out of the stakes-winning Bluegrass Cat mare Plus One. The dam has two winners, both by Violence, from three foals to race.

First Randy Romero Pure Courage Award to Mena

The group of nine friends from Louisiana that launched the Randy Romero Pure Courage Award this year to honor the Racing Hall of Fame rider who died in 2019, as well as current jockeys who overcome adversity, announced their

first winner Feb. 20: Miguel Mena.

Mena battled back from severe injuries suffered in a spill March 18, 2018, at Fair Grounds Race Course & Slots, where he suffered multiple fractures in his right heel and ankle. At the time, he was the meet's leading rider. He returned to riding later that year and earned a pair of grade 3 wins in 2019 at Keeneland, guiding Bobby's Wicked One to victory in the Commonwealth Stakes and Peace Achieved to a score in the Dixiana Bourbon Stakes. Organizers noted that Mena prevailed in a close vote that included finalists Tim Thornton, Victor Espinoza, and Kendrick Carmouche.

Romero, a winner of 4,294 races and \$75.2 million in earnings from 1973-99, was the regular rider of such elite distaffers as Go for Wand and Personal Ensign, with whom he teamed to win the Breeders' Cup Distaff (G1) in 1988 to complete an unbeaten career. He won 122 graded stakes and riding titles at 10 tracks.

Keeneland and Churchill Downs Announce Racing and Training Reforms

Keeneland and Churchill Downs jointly announced major changes in racing and training policies to strengthen safety protocols at both race tracks. Reforms include mandatory veterinary inspections prior to workouts and race entry and enhanced reporting and transparency requirements for trainers and attending veterinarians with regard to the fitness of horses to work and race.

Keeneland and Churchill Downs will ban the race-day use of Lasix in all 2-year-old races under the International Medication Protocol

authority granted in the Kentucky Administrative Regulations beginning with Keeneland's 2020 Spring Meet and following at Churchill Downs Racetrack's 2020 Spring Meet.

Changes will become effective with the opening of the stable areas at Keeneland and Churchill Downs.

Trainers and attending veterinarians must agree to the following conditions in order to participate in the racing programs at either track:

A trainer is not permitted to enter a horse in any race unless the horse has been found fit to race by the attending veterinarian during the three days immediately prior to entry, and a trainer is not permitted to work a horse unless the horse has been found fit to work by the attending veterinarian during the five days immediately before the work.

Trainers and attending veterinarians

are obligated to inform the equine medical director at the appropriate race track and the KHRC of any changes in a horse's fitness after an examination has been conducted.

Additionally, all horses at Keeneland and Churchill Downs will be subject to veterinary inspections by the tracks' respective equine medical directors and to veterinary monitoring.

Record Low in 2019 for Equine Fatalities in Racing

Despite a rash of breakdowns at Santa Anita Park, the overall number of catastrophic injuries during racing fell 8.9% in 2019 compared with 2018.

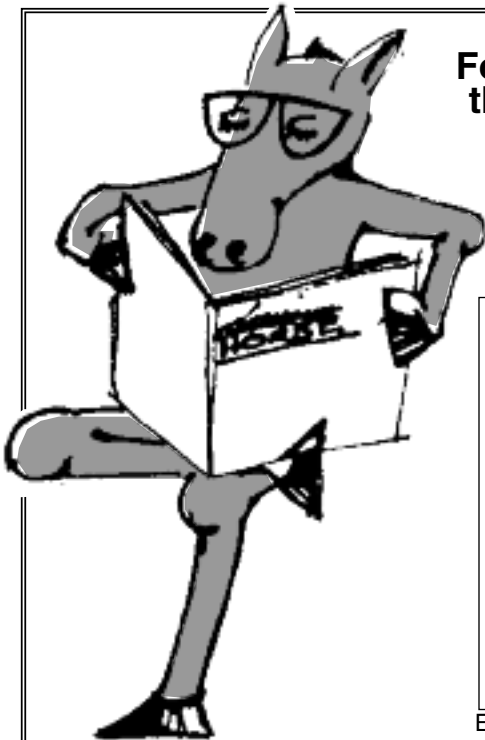
The equine fatality rate of 1.53 per 1,000 starts is the safest year on

record in the 11 years The Jockey Club Equine Injury Database has tracked such incidents in the United States and Canada. The EID tracks equine fatalities during racing, which allows wide participation and facilitates comparison from year to year.

Based on the 2019 data, 99.84% of flat racing starts at the racetracks participating in the EID were completed without a fatality. The overall drop in the risk of fatal injury from 2009-19 was 23.5%.

Although many factors are associated with racing fatalities, the annual summaries traditionally have been prepared by surface type. The incidence of fatality per 1,000 starts by racing surface for 2019 showed a big reduction on dirt, though turf racing had a spike, raising concern.

"Although the incidence of racing fatalities on dirt surfaces

reached an all-time low in 2019 of 1.60, the results on turf increased from 1.20 in 2018 to 1.56 in 2019. The number of starts on turf has been trending upward, and this increase in fatalities likely indicates a set of risk factors unique to turf racing may be driving the results," said Dr. Tim Parkin, a professor of veterinary epidemiology at the

University of Glasgow.

TCA's Horses First Fund Supports Backstretch and Aftercare Organizations Amid Pandemic

Thoroughbred Charities of America's Horses First Fund is providing funding to backstretch and aftercare organizations working to support the Thoroughbred community amid the COVID-19 pandemic. Established in 2016 by LNJ Foxwoods, the Horses First Fund assists Thoroughbreds and their caretakers in need of emergency aid due to large scale neglect, natural disaster, or other catastrophe.

The Backstretch Employee Service Team (BEST) will receive funding to support their on-site medical clinic at Belmont Park. The Sam Houston Race Park Chaplaincy will receive an emergency grant to provide meal services for backstretch workers at the now closed racetrack. The Horses First Fund will also provide grants to several aftercare organizations throughout the U.S. that have taken in additional Thoroughbreds due to the pandemic. It is expected that more funding will be distributed as further emergency needs are identified. TCA has worked to stay in touch with its grantees throughout this

uncertain time. One concern, echoed by numerous grantees, is for the loss of revenue due to cancelled fundraisers and events. Louisiana Program To Offer COVID-19 Small Business Help

John Bel Edwards announced a new Louisiana Loan Portfolio Guaranty Program, which will offer loans of up to \$100,000 to Louisiana small businesses of fewer than 100 employees that are impacted by the COVID-19 crisis. To help Main Street and rural businesses sustain operations, the loans will require no payments for 180 days and carry below-market interest rates of no more than 3.5 percent.

The Loan Portfolio Guaranty Program, or LPGP, is a partnership of Louisiana Economic Development, which will provide a loan guaranty fund; the Louisiana Bankers Association, whose membership will provide the loans; and the Louisiana Public Facilities Authority, which will administer the program. A total loan pool of \$50 million will be quickly disbursed to eligible small businesses across Louisiana.

The Louisiana loan program partners — LED, LBA and LPFA — envision helping small businesses meet critical needs for operating their firms during and beyond the disruption of the COVID-19 pandemic.

“The beauty of this program is we are not competing with the essential financial products offered by the U.S. Small Business Administration — we are complementing SBA,” LED Secretary Don Pierson said.

LPGP loans will provide up to \$100,000 in immediate financing to help small firms impacted by COVID-19 meet their payroll, retain employees, pay their rent and mortgages, and keep their lights on and their doors open. Interested businesses may find loan details at OpportunityLouisiana.com/covid19, and a list of participating bankers will be posted at the site by Friday as banks complete their participation agreements.

Through the program, bankers will have the flexibility to extend loan terms for up to five years, while interest rates will be below conventional commercial lending rates and no higher than 3.5 percent. To date, participating banks have requested allocations for about two-thirds of the \$50 million in loan capacity available through LPGP.
